

First Solemn Holy Communion & Confirmation candidates of this year attended the **initiation ceremony** and were bestowed






with special blessings from the Bishop, along with receiving a Bible and textbook.

Bishop met with our youth community inspiring them to deepen their understanding of faith and to serve as a role model for the younger generation.








Christingle Eve
