LENT 2024:-

As we walk together through the Lenten desert of repentance, with faith-filled longing, and through your cleansing touch, may our hearts and spirits grow and be transformed in the renewed hope and joy that Jesus Christ offers. Ash Monday has marked the beginning of this season, calling us to a season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. In his Lenten message for 2024, Holy Father Pope Francis has reminded us of the theme "Through the Desert, God Leads Us to Freedom", drawn from the book of Exodus, which speaks about the journey of conversion and renewal that Lent offers us - a journey from bondage to spiritual freedom

Adoration and Way of the Cross: -During lent, there will be adoration on every Thursdays and way of the cross on every Fridays and Sundays before the Holy Qurbana. I call your attention and sincere participation in this.

Lenten Retreat: -

In God's great love, let us spend some time with him to listen and meditate on His words and to examine our hearts, to heal our souls, to pray humbly with purity and sincerity. As I had announced earlier, our parish retreat will be held on March 15th-17th. It is a great blessing to have Rev Sr Ann Maria with us from March 12th onwards for a week. I encourage everyone to make use of this golden opportunity for spiritual counseling either single or with your family. Please book a slot at your convenience ahead of time.

Holy Week Observances: -

Holy Week, is the last week of Lent, which starts with Palm Sunday and leads through the Last Supper, His crucifixion, and ends on Easter Sunday with His resurrection. We observe Holy Week with special solemnity as a time of devotion. I gently remind you that, Good Friday is a day of fasting for us Catholics and to refrain from eating meat.

As we journey through Lent, may our hearts be filled with grace, our minds renewed, and our spirits enkindled with the light and hope of the Resurrection.
